Meeting called to Order by Sheila GRANT at 11:40 a.m.

Chris BEAUCHAMP read treasurer's report. Increase in membership dues to \$30. Increase approved, 1st Darlene MANCELL and 2nd Dena GRASDAL, all in favour, no opposed. Chris spoke of the budget, justifying increase in fees. Motion to accept budget: 1st Deb WARNER, 2nd Kathy LITTLE. All in favour, no opposed

Dena GRASDAL discussed "Ringers, Chip-Ins, Birdies" Please circle the score on scorecard for the hole birdied, and put a square around the score on the scorecard for the chip-in. Possible to have a square and circle on same score for a chip-in birdie. Dena asks that you write on the top of the score card birdies and chip-ins to assist her in identifying those that get a chip-in or birdie.

Aileen FLETCHER discussed handicaps and how 5 games are necessary to create a temporary handicap. Aileen also discussed changes to Scramble. Scramble fees are \$5 (\$2 for prizes, \$3 lunch) and that lunch will *always* take place if Scramble is cancelled due to weather so there will be a collection of \$3/person to cover lunch costs. Wanda BRUNER is the new Member at Large and Mary MEATH is the new Treasurer on the Scramble Committee.
