Guest Lorne WILLISON spoke of League Rules and clarification of what the men have been playing regarding the ball being moved on the fairway only, not closer to the pin, to improve your lie (a grip length). Empty pond is a penalty area, but you can play out of it. You can remove debris, stones, etc from around the ball as long as it doesn't move. 2 stroke penalty to bring ball back from where it went over the fence, or tee off again with a 1 stroke penalty. One can mark your ball on the green with your permission and either the marker or the owner of the ball can replace it. Marking is from the side or behind the ball only.
