Rules 2023 2024 Sands RV

The Sands Golf League will be played under the USGA Rules of Golf along with the following Local Rules.

Winter Rules – If the ball comes to rest in your own fairway (closely mown grass), you may bump or roll the ball to another place in the fairway no closer to the hole within the length of a standard golf grip.

Model Local Rules E-5 – If the ball is Lost or Out of bounds on a Par 4 hole, an additional relief option is available providing a provisional ball has NOT been played.

The additional option is to move up to where your ball crossed the boundary fence or the spot the ball is deemed to be lost (Reference Point) and drop a ball within 2 club lengths from edge of fairway, equal distance from the hole as the Reference Point is from the hole.

If a provisional ball was played then this local rule is not an available option. The provisional ball is now the ball in play if the original ball is lost or out of bounds.

Unplayable ball. – At any place on the course that is not in a penalty area, the ball can be declared unplayable and a ball may be dropped within 2 club lengths of where the ball came to rest, not closer to hole. The penalty is 1 stroke. An example of this is when your ball is in the Oleanders along the boundary fences.
