January 27, 2026

### Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

The minutes from the last meeting were approved following a motion by Kathy Little, seconded by Bev Whitehead. The motion passed unanimously.

### Good and Welfare

No new items were reported under Good and Welfare.

### Budget and Membership Report

Donna Sylvestre provided updates on both the budget and membership. The Women's Club's total cash balance stands at \$4,653.70.

Current membership includes 87 members, with 70 golfers and 17 non-golfers. Regarding phone books, 107 have been sold and three have been gifted to Stacy, the Pro Shop, and for editorial purposes. Ten phone books remain available for purchase. Sales have totaled \$535, while the cost of printing is \$321.36, resulting in a profit of \$213.64.

For ECCY, the budget was \$230 and actual expenses amounted to \$235.80. There were 108 golfers participating.

### Rules

Bev Whitehead has taken over responsibility for the Rules Committee from Roberta Burroughs. She recommended members review the rules printout and led a discussion on the differences between winter and summer rules. Members were reminded that golfers are not permitted to pick up and clean their balls.

### Handicaps

Roberta Burroughs announced the most improved golfers for the club.

### Ladies Day

The creation of Linda Sylvester's pairings and winnings support team were acknowledged. The Treasurer will now receive envelopes containing winnings to be distributed during the scramble; money will no longer be kept in the pro shop.

### Tournaments

Cindy Hansen and Carrie Dallaway provided an update on upcoming tournaments. Linda Schilling discussed the Can-Am event scheduled for February 20th and reminded members to sign up prior to February 10th. American volunteers are needed to serve at the event, and Wally Holsted will be responsible for pairings. Sign-up sheets for the upcoming season are now available.

Planning for the Club Championship is under the supervision of Roberta Burroughs and Cindy Hansen.

Nancy Perry reported there was no update regarding the scramble.

### Chip-ins, Birdies, and Ringers

Linda Sylvester will assume responsibility for the ad hoc nominations committee from Deb Harrison. There are open positions for president and vice president, and all members are encouraged to consider possible nominees.
